Principal Matters

4.1 Tuesday 3rd October 2023

It has been so good to hear students tell stories about what they got up to over the holidays. But now it is time to welcome back our students ready for the final term of this year.

Teachers have reminded students how important this last term is for keeping up with work and putting in their best effort to be ready for all the challenges of next year.

Term 4 arrangements:

Parents are reminded that students need to have a broad-brimmed **hat** for outdoor activities during this term. Even though it is raining today, we know that the weather will quickly turn to being bright and sunny and students will need protection.

Due to the possibility of **snakes**, we also have some restricted spaces around the school during the summer months – especially those areas that are adjacent to bush. Students are well aware of these **out-of-bounds areas** and have been provided with a clear plan of response in the event of seeing a snake. Fortunately, this has rarely happened, but we always need to be prepared.

Our school is in the list of schools who must close on days that have a fire rating forecast of 'Catastrophic'. On any days like this, no staff member, student or parent is permitted to be on the school site. Hopefully this won't happen very often, but in the event of this weather designation, parents will be advised at least the day before. In this situation, parents are advised to consider their own fire plans and how to respond safely as a family to this risk.

St John First Aid:

Alyce from St John First Aid has come to the school today to provide all students with what to do if confronted with a first aid situation. It is not a full course, but it has provided students with an understanding of assessing the danger of a situation, the responsiveness of the patient, and then how to correctly call an ambulance. The senior students also got to practise putting a patient in the recovery position and performing CPR.
